SUBJECT: Proposed Amendment of 1B SBCCC 100.1 - Definitions

DATE: January 25, 2022

The State Board of Community Colleges has initiated the rulemaking process to amend **1B SBCCC 100.1 - Definitions**. This amendment adds a definition for "Hybrid Flexible (HyFlex)" to the types of approved instruction methods in State board governance.

The proposed amendment is published on the NC Community College System's website, www.nccommunitycolleges.edu/sbcccode. For your convenience, a copy of the proposed rule, with the changes indicated, are attached to this memorandum. Strikethroughs indicate deletions of existing language and underlines indicate additions of language.

Any member of the public has the right to submit written comments on the proposed rule. Please note that any person who submits public comments on behalf of their community college should comply with their college's local process for submitting comments on a proposed rule. Written comments on the rule must be received by no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 3, 2022. Any member of the public has the right to request a hearing on the proposed rule. The following definitions apply to this Chapter.

- (a) "Traditional Instruction" College curriculum or continuing education course in which 100% of the instruction is delivered face to face with the instructor in the physical presence of students.
- (b) "Online Instruction" College curriculum or continuing education course in which 100% of the instruction is delivered online.
- (c) "Hybrid Instruction" College curriculum or continuing education course in
 which greater than 50%, but less than 100% of the instruction is delivered
 online.
- (d) "Blended Instruction" College curriculum or continuing education course in which
 less than or equal to 50% of the instruction is delivered online.
 - (e) "Hybrid Flexible (HyFlex)" College curriculum or continuing education courses that provide students an opportunity to choose whether to attend classes during regularly scheduled in-person sessions or participate online synchronously or asynchronously.
